






But when 98-year-old neighbour Mr. Krekeler announces that he plans to pass away soon, Magali is torn out of her position as an observer. Mr. Krekeler's whole extended, peculiar family comes to see him. Together with Kieran, Mr. Krekeler's 13-year-old grandson, she finds out about Mr. Krekeler's life, gets to know and like him and begins to wonder what actually makes a "good life". Touched and inspired by Mr. Krekeler, Magali starts to take things in her own hands – and Kieran plays a big role in that...

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What is particularly important to you about the novel?

Magali's view on things, which is razor-sharp and sometimes merciless, but at the same time humorous and with an unerring sense of the oddities we are surrounded by. For me, writing this novel also meant walking through the world and suddenly noticing all kinds of curiosities: Rearview mirrors on eyeglasses, useless construction sites, ice cream for dogs, special offers for coffins. Yes, even the morbid has funny sides.

How did you manage to maintain a light tone in the novel and still address the weighty questions of life and death without trivializing them?

The tone came directly from Magali's point of view. Already because of her physical length, she looks at her fellow human beings with a certain distance, but also with a longing for touch. At first, she perceives everything and everyone with the same attention: the backhouse quarrel between the neighbours Joël and Claire Hummel, the meditative phase of her sister Malve, the eternally plastered Kieran, the depressed husky Snow, and the very old Mr. Krekeler and his decision to die. Everything is equally interesting, everything has meaning.

Why was it important to you that Magali be such a tall young woman? Was she supposed to struggle with her body because many teenagers do at that age? Or is there something else behind it?

All teenagers quarrel with their bodies. And all of them are this strange, transforming body. Very tall girls, I can tell you from my own experience, have to grow into their height first. They literally don't fit the mold and lose their cuteness bonus very early. No one feels the need to protect them. This is also how Magali feels on her forays through the neighborhood. She has to manage on her own, which sometimes hurts. But it allows her to look out at the world independently from her post.

Mr. Krekeler is an old man like we would probably all like to have as a neighbor. Why does he succeed in what so many fail at, namely living a full, lively life and dying with dignity?

First of all, Mr. Krekeler is an ordinary man looking back on an ordinary life. He has weaknesses like everyone else, for example in his dealings with Louis, his son. But he is good at making decisions and bearing the consequences, not only with regard to his

life, but also to his dying. He avoids burdening others with his affairs. Instead, he says goodbye unsentimentally. For him, dying with dignity means saying: 98 years, my goodness! That's enough now.


It doesn't get any better than this.

You received a lot of attention and recognition for your last novel "Schön wie die Acht" (Beautiful Like An Eight). Did this inspire you to write or did it rather create a certain pressure of expectation?

It inspired me! The pressure is there anyway, I create it myself - with this darned demand to produce something new, qualitatively different, possibly better with every book. The recognition for "Schön wie die Acht" has given me the feeling that this effort is worthwhile and that, with a bit of luck, the result will be seen. That motivates. It's more the market mechanisms, which follow other criteria than literary ones that block me.

Do you write a diary yourself?


Yes, but only irregularly. Today, I put most of my writing impulses into my literary texts. Not only my thoughts and ideas, but also everyday observations find space there - in transformed form. That was different in the time when I didn't write books yet. I don't know who I would have been as a teenager without a diary in which to vent about myself and the world gone mad.



A Genius' Diary

Tomke keeps a diary. He hardly ever feels like talking.
His parents send him to occupational therapy, logotherapy, a discussion group, and a relaxation through self-hypnosis group. Recently, on Fridays, he has to report his school day to grandma after which he gets a treat.

But Tomke needs a break. After all, he is not stupid. He just stutters, so what? He can choose himself what he needs and he doesn't like yoga or soccer as his parents suggest. So he decides to join his classmate Delia to her roller-skating club. Delia is really cool, so much that Tomke even forgets to stutter sometimes. But even if he doesn't, it does not matter!

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
My Sandwich
